

## **Grace Abbott Elementary PTO Meeting**

**Tuesday, May 1, 2018**

**Welcome/Introduction** of Board Members and meeting attendees. The meeting was called to order at 6:34 PM by Dr. Chaussee.

**Review April Meeting Minutes** Erin Barry motioned to approve the minutes from April. Cheri Shoup seconded the motion.

**Principal Report** The new tether ball clips arrived on Thursday (as a replacement for the first set that broke). Mr. Williams presented to each class the rules of tether ball and how to use the tether balls appropriately. Unfortunately, one has broken again. Dr. Chaussee will be researching a softer ball to use with the clips.

Dr. Chaussee visited with a couple of people in the district about the walking track. He requested that a district representative come and speak with the PTO regarding whether or not this will ever be a possibility for the school, and if not, why that decision has been made. At this point, that meeting has not been scheduled. A final decision on the track will need to be postponed until next school year. In the future, the district may change their restrictions on PTOs purchasing technology. It may be an option to use the money that had been set aside for the walking track for technology items instead. Other items were discussed for the PTO to purchase such as funding field trips, new desks in classrooms, new classroom projectors, and funding for flexible seating.

State testing finished last Friday, and MAP testing began May 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Treasurer Report** Final numbers for the carnival are not yet available. We will have one more Box Top and Bakers deposit this year from Cash Rewards. An additional educational grant was added.
